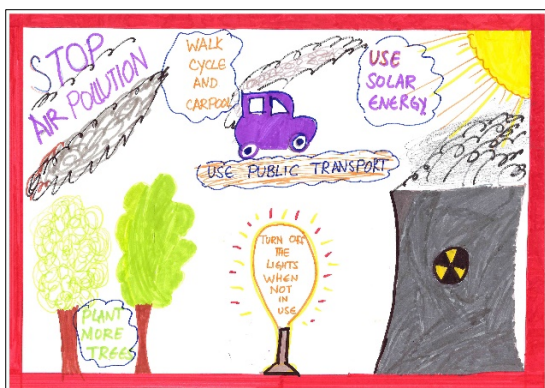
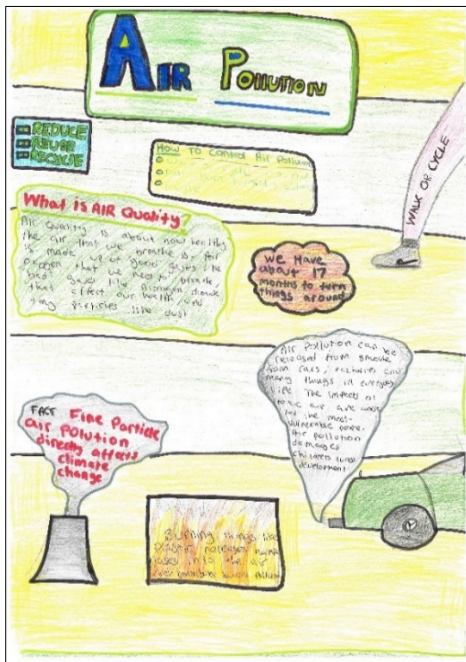
News & Update

'Reach for the Stars' project

Thank you to CPL Group who provided funding for our "Reach for the Stars" project. This project provides a tailored programme of activities to support and encourage students with self-confidence issues, low self-esteem and exam stress.

Sukhi Cooper, School Business Manager and Data and Exams Manager said:

"Many of our students are from hard to reach families, vulnerable/ disadvantaged backgrounds who have a range of social, emotional and mental health issues, added with behavioural issues that, as a result, make it difficult for them to cope with the pressure of exams. Many believe they are not 'good enough'.

This funding will help us to deliver a bespoke programme of activities, planned in partnership with a local Emotional Health & Wellbeing Service, as well as the school's pastoral team, to provide targeted exam support for our students.



Motivational Conference

In preparing our Yr11s for their final examinations we hosted our annual motivational conference. We do this prior to mock examinations to encourage students to start to focus and prepare for both their mock and final examinations.

This year we were very lucky to have Rianna come in and give us a really powerful motivational talk.



Christmas Shoebox Appeal

As a school community we wanted to support 'Operation Christmas Child'. This project run by Samaritan's Purse delivers shoeboxes filled with small toys, hygiene items, and school supplies to children affected by war, poverty, natural disaster, famine and disease.

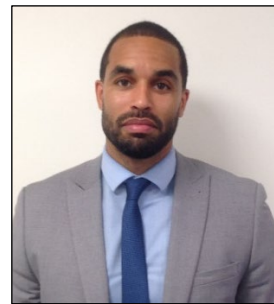
