Sports Day is a key date in the Summer term for both staff and students. We had a successful day with lots of enthusiasm from the students, and some great achievements in both the track and field events.

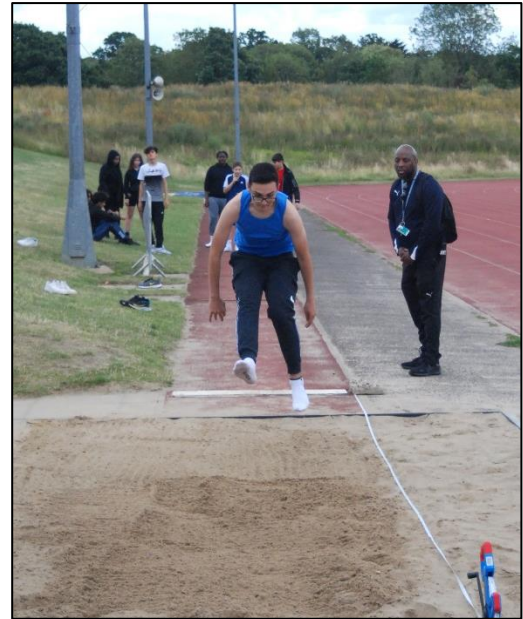
