Dear Parents/Carers,

Changes to Uniform

I am writing to inform you of a change to our school uniform that will be introduced from the start of term, Monday 4th September 2018. The change is being introduced to improve the current standard of uniform being worn by students in the school and to ensure smarter standards of appearance from our students.

Students will no longer wear a TJA polo shirt, they will wear a plain white shirt with a new school tie. We are also replacing our current burgundy jumper with a black v-neck jumper embroidered with the TJA logo. Students will continue to wear black trousers or a skirt.

I am giving you advanced warning of this change to ensure that if you are buying items of school uniform between now and start of the new academic year that you are aware of the new requirements.

I enclose a uniform voucher which entitles you one school tie and one black v-neck embroidered jumper free of charge. You will need to go to our current school uniform, Teeny wear (address details are included on the voucher). Uniform will be available from 20th August.

We expect all boys to wear a belt to ensure their trousers are fitted correctly and secure at their waists. Nothing should be visible underneath their school trousers. Girls are expected to wear skirts which sit appropriately above their knee, no shorter than this.

I hope the advance notice of this new requirement will enable you to plan your uniform purchases for the new academic year. Despite this change, our uniform still remains cost effective, comfortable and easy to wear.

Thank you in advance for your co-operation in this matter and for your support for the standards we wish to uphold as a school.
